- The computer at the Pilot's Station at the terminal building has been rebuilt and seems to be operating without any issues. The unit was infected by a virus and would not allow pilots to log-in to file their flight plans.
- Dave Moyer will offer a presentation to the members of the Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau on March 20. The presentation will focus on promoting the convenience of the Airport for the member's and for Pocono visitors.
- New keypad combination locks have been installed on the exterior door of the pilot's lounge and on the exterior door to the new north hangar bathroom. This will enable pilots to utilize the pilots lounge after hours and allow the flying club members to access the north hangar bathroom after hours.
