We have completed Recurrent training Moyer people on Jet fueling & Towing jets, opening & closing procedures. Our office staff is also current on invoicing & they have been answering the airport phone most of the time.

Fuel Pricing

100LL our cost June 27 3.70 /gal our posted retail 5.29 1.59 mark up JETA our cost June 27 2.55/gal " 4.89 2.34 mark up I checked prices locally and although we are a little higher then average Our main competition on Jet ,AVP Is .20 higher & ABE is .04 lower HZL is .24 cents lower

100LL is all over the place from .55 lower at Lehighton to .99 higher at AVP Of course this is a little more sensitive and some of the small planes will travel for price. Note: since our delivery there has been an increase in our price of 100LL to 3.84 & 2.62 for JetA

Let me know if you want to make any changes. I would recommend we keep them where they are until our next delivery

We have more room in the hangars since some hangar tenant's have moved. This will involve three or four aircraft added. I am contacting those on the list, and will see Mark to have them added with new leases.
